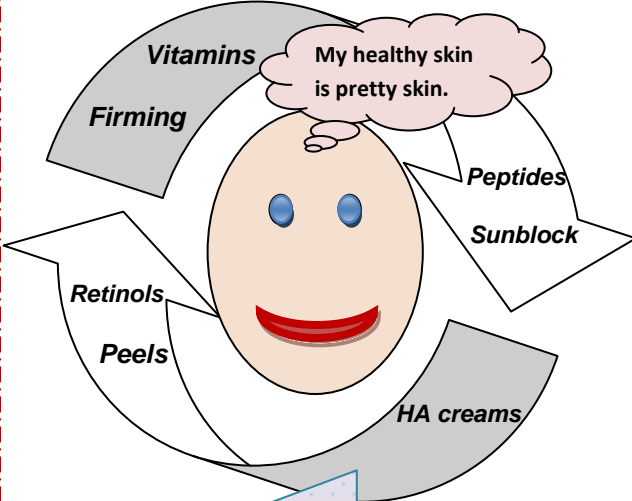


Ever wonder why
